



An Táin Arts Centre | Covid-19 Health and Safety Measures

An Táin Arts Centre is committed to the well-being of our audience, artists and employees. To assist our community in preventing the spread of Covid-19, we are adhering to Government recommendations and implementing enhanced health and safety protocols across our venue. Health and safety measures will be updated as new guidelines are released, with full details available on our website.

An Táin Arts Centre's Covid-19 Compliance Officer is CEO, Paul Hayes. If you have any concerns in advance of your visit, please contact paul@antain.ie.

- Face coverings are now mandatory in galleries, theatres and retail spaces. Please wear your face covering when visiting us. If you have a medical reason for not wearing a face covering, please contact us so we can make arrangements for your visit.
- Where possible, we are promoting a one-way experience that reinforces social distancing guidelines. 'Keep Left' at all times.
- Please make use of our hand sanitising stations at entry and exit points.
- Additional hand sanitiser dispensers are placed at key points throughout the building.
- We have removed excess furniture from the foyer to limit congestion and dwell time.
- Additional signage to promote hand washing and best hygiene practices has been posted throughout the building.
- We have set up a designated Covid-19 room.
- We are frequently cleaning and disinfecting throughout the building.
- Staff are taking regular hand-washing breaks.
- Additional training and PPE has been provided for all staff.
- Toilets are for customer use only. They will be cleaned frequently.
- An Táin Arts Centre's bar will remain closed until further notice.
- Visitor capacity has been reduced in our gallery to allow for social distancing.
- We have installed protective screens at box office and gallery.

- We are currently only accepting card payment. Keypads will be wiped down after each customer. If you cannot pay by card, please contact us in advance of your visit and we will work with you to make other arrangements.
- We will endeavour to keep queues as short as possible and appreciate your patience.
- We are currently operating a paper-free booking system. Your booking will be recorded at time of purchase and entry to the event will be managed through a customer list.
- Tickets for all events must be pre-booked, and will not be available to purchase at the time of the event.
- All seated events are currently being transitioned to an unallocated seating model to allow us to best manage current social distancing requirements.
- As our theatres reopen for seated events, we will update this document with current protocols.

What can you do to help us promote a healthy environment?

We are doing all we can to promote a healthy environment, and rely on you to adhere to public health recommendations for your safety and the safety of others.
