

LOUTH CULTURE QUEST Public Health & Safety Document

We are excited for you to begin the challenge of completing the Louth Culture Quest, before you begin please read through the following health and safety instructions.

- At some of the sites parking is limited and you will need to park at a distance and walk to the location of the artwork.
- Do not block entrances or exits while parking your car.
- Be mindful to not obstruct footpaths or hinder drivers or pedestrians while parking your car.
- Always park in an appropriate parking space.
- As Zone 2 Dundalk and Zone 4 Drogheda can be completed by walking, we advise finding a secure location to park and continuing the quest by foot.
- There is limited lighting at various locations throughout the quest, do not attempt to complete the quest in hours of dim light or darkness.
- A number of the locations may have rough terrain, please ensure you are wearing appropriate footwear and take caution while your walk at each location.
- There are some locations that are prone to strong winds. Please take this into consideration while on the quest and do not proceed if there is severe weather or a local weather warning.
- Some of the artworks are placed in the vicinity of the road. Please be mindful of vehicular traffic when crossing the road or when viewing the artworks.
- Do not climb on any of the artworks.
- Do not cause damage to the artworks or the area where they are located.

The Louth Culture Quest will bring you to 20 different heritage landmarks and sites of cultural importance, please be mindful of the nature of these sites and be respectful of the art works and the surrounding area.
